

Guidelines for fair use of e-Resources at CSIR-IIIM, Jammu

CSIR-Indian Institute of Integrative Medicine, Jammu subscribes to electronic resources (e-resources) through various sources like - NKRC and direct subscriptions. All these electronic resources are governed by license agreements for their fair use by the legitimate users.

The licenses for e-resources impose two types of restrictions on their usage:

- i) Legitimate Users - defines authorized users for e-resources, which generally includes students, faculty, staff and onsite visitors within the Institute;
- ii) How the e-resources can be used - defines how these resources can be used.

Following are the broader guidelines:

Dos:

- ✓ View, download, copy, print and save a copy of search results;
- ✓ Search, view, download, copy, print and save individual articles; and
- ✓ Use e-resources for academic / scientific research purposes.

Don'ts:

- Excessive, programmatic (use of automated tools like – Web Crawlers, Spiders or robots or intelligent agents) or systematically download (copy or print of an entire journal issue or volume or large portions of other e-resources). ***For example, you cannot download entire / major / large portion of an issue of a journal or print out several copies of the same article;***
- Distribute, transmit the e-resource to others, either in electronic or hard-copy format. It may be permissible to forward an article to another colleague within own institution by email, however, transmitting an article to someone outside the institution, or to a large group of recipients, a mailing list, or an electronic bulletin board, is not allowed;
- Use of e-resources for any purpose other than academic, scientific research purposes; like - commercial purposes (i.e., reselling, redistributing or re-publishing licensed content) or in an illegal or otherwise improper manner is strictly restricted;
- Violation of any copyright, trademark, patent, or other intellectual property right associated with the e-resources

It is the responsibility of individual user to ensure that IIIM e-resources are used for educational and research purposes and not for any commercial purposes.

Any violation of license agreements of the publishers / the above guidelines, will be the sole responsibility of the individual user and he/she will be liable to pay the financial penalty as may be imposed by the concerned publisher(s).
